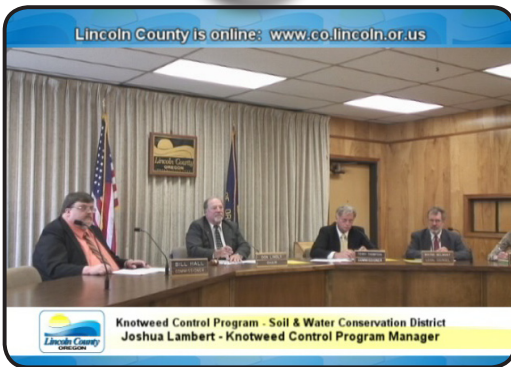
## Board Of Commissioners



### Video programming connecting county and community...

Each week the Board of Commissioners meet at the Lincoln County Courthouse in a regularly scheduled meeting in Room 108 at 9:30 am. These meetings are open to the public and filmed for broadcast the following week on Charter Cable and available online typically within one working day.

The BOC sets policies for the County in this legislative process by developing and adopting ordinances, making appointments to boards and committees and conducting quasi-judicial proceedings and hearings.

Meetings facilitate the interaction of people and information. County departments, public agencies and community organizations work together to achieve consensus on collective goals.

The public is encouraged to attend and observe this weekly event. BOC Meetings are an opportunity to look inside and participate in the mechanics of the governmental process.

From 2007 - 2009 Lincoln County aired a cable television show entitled "Inside Lincoln County." 31 episodes of the half-hour cable television news magazine were produced to keep Lincoln County residents abreast of the programs and services provided by local county government. Lincoln County Television continues to broadcast previously aired programs each month.
