**“CrimeReports” Network – Lincoln County Sheriff’s Office**

Lincoln County Sheriff Dennis Dotson and Lt. Curtis Landers explained a new service available to the Sheriff’s Office and the public, CrimeReports, which is the largest online resource for accurate, up-to-date crime information. The Lincoln City Police Department also utilizes the service, and it’s currently under consideration by the Newport Police Department. The program will benefit law enforcement by providing a visual of specific criminal activity occurring in any given area, indicating where patrolling efforts could best be utilized. Citizens can access data regarding crimes by entering location or address, incident type, and date range at no charge by logging onto [www.CrimeReports.com](http://www.CrimeReports.com). A direct link to CrimeReports will be available on the Sheriff’s Office website in the near future.
