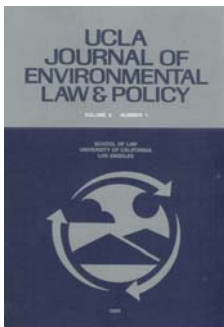
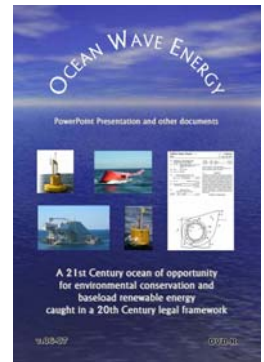

Energy Policy Bio

- Rob serves as the elected District Attorney for Lincoln County, Oregon. Prior to being elected District Attorney, Rob served as a lawyer for Lincoln County, beginning in 1992. Among other things, Rob successfully defended County home rule authority to provide utility service. *GTE (nka Verizon) v PUC and Lincoln County*, 179 Or App 46, 39 P3d 201, rev den 334 Or 492 (2002).
- In 2007, Rob served as a lobbyist and advocate for the development of progressive ocean wave energy law and policy at state and federal levels. Rob is the author of Oregon's ocean wave energy laws (Enrolled SB 875; Enrolled HJM 22).
- During college, Rob studied energy production and policy at the Energy Institute of the University of La Verne, La Verne, CA (1983-1987).
- During law school, Rob studied environmental and energy law and policy at Northwestern School of Law of Lewis & Clark College, Portland, OR (1987-1990).



- In 1988, Rob helped organize a symposium on emerging superconductivity technology at Northwestern School of Law of Lewis & Clark College. Rob also authored a law review article on the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act (PURPA) and Superconducting Magnetic Energy Storage (SMES), 8 UCLA Journal of Environmental Law and Policy 73. In 1990, Rob was invited to speak at the annual international conference on superconductivity.
- In 1988 and 1989, Rob drafted public utility and energy legislation and legal opinions for the Oregon Office of Legislative Counsel.
- Rob has provided dozens of community, educational, and legislative presentations about energy law and policy.
- Rob is married and has four children – three in college and one in the National Guard – so Rob is aging a bit faster than normal.
