10 more, including families, friends and communities; and

12 Whereas crime exacts an emotional, physical, psychological, and financial toll on victims as
13 they have lost loved ones, life savings, physical and mental health, and sense of security; and

15 Whereas more than 30 years of progress for crime victims stands on the shoulders of
16 dedicated advocates and brave victims who worked to gain a voice, rights, and respect; and

18 Whereas we applaud the progress that our nation has made in recognizing crime's impact on
19 victims and celebrate advocates and survivors who, through their determination, brought rights and
20 resources for victims and have changed the course of history; and

22 Whereas more work remains to be done to address the impacts of crime and meet the needs
23 of victims of non-violent crime, victims of terrorism, and other underserved victims; and

25 Whereas our history teaches us that, by working together, we can help victims of crime
26 reshape their destinies and ensure they receive the support they need, the respect they deserve, and
27 the rights they have earned; and

29 Whereas National Crime Victims' Rights Week, April 10 to 16, 2011, provides an
30 opportunity for us to reshape the future for victims by honoring the past and reflecting on hard-won
31 victories, and to recommit to working together to insist on better treatment for victims to help them
32 overcome the harm caused by crime; and

34 Whereas we are joining forces with victim service programs, criminal justice officials, and
35 concerned citizens throughout Lincoln County to raise awareness of victims' rights and observe
36 National Crime Victims' Rights Week;

38 NOW, THEREFORE, we, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners do hereby proclaim


