

## Reed Canarygrass



Stout perennial that regenerates from large rootstocks, with stems 2 to 7 feet tall that are covered with a waxy coating that gives it a blue-green color. Leaf blades are flat,  $\frac{1}{4}$  to  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches wide. The panicle is more or less compact at first, and then the branches spread.

This aggressive species is found on wet ground, along streams and in marshes in the entire western region. It is especially a problem when growing in canals and irrigation ditches.
