Ambulance Service Review Committee (ASRC) Committee Member Volunteer Job Description

Position: Public Member

Committee Assignment: Member of the Ambulance Service Review Committee (ASRC), created to advise and assist the Board of Commissioners on matters related to the coordinate of the Lincoln County Ambulance Service Plans within Lincoln County.

Appointment: Candidates are selected by the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners. Appointments to the ASRC are based on the candidate who best meets the requirements of the Committee and are made at the sole discretion of the Commissioners.

Term of Office: Members are appointed for a two-year term and may serve successive terms. Terms begin on appointment date for a rolling two-year term.

Qualifications: To be qualified to serve on the Committee, an individual must:

- a) reside or work in Lincoln County and must
- b) have an interest in assisting the ASRC with representing the public at large in regards to ambulance provider services within or traveling to and from the County.

Committee Responsibilities: The ASRC has four primary responsibilities, which are carried out with the support of Lincoln County staff assigned to assist with the Committee:

The Ambulance Service Review Committee (ASRC) shall have the following powers and duties (LCC 7.840):

- (a) Provide a review process for a regular random sampling of ambulance services rendered in Lincoln County by each ambulance service provider.
- (b) Provide a forum for review of complaints by consumers and others concerning the quality of ambulance services provided in Lincoln County.
- (c) Make recommendations to the Board of Commissioners in accordance with LCC 7.832(1) for revocation or suspension of an ambulance service area assignment, when such recommendation appears appropriate pursuant to LCC 7.832.
- (d) Periodically review the Lincoln County Ambulance Service Area Plan and make recommendations to the Board of Commissioners concerning proposed updates and amendments to the plan.

Committee Member Responsibilities:

- Review provided committee packets, agendas prior to scheduled meetings
- Attend quarterly meetings, approximately 2 hours per quarter, and advocate on behalf of the general public in discussions and decision making
