11 Lincoln County Orders No. 6-20-169, 7-20-190 and 8-20-239 extended restrictions  
12 on short term lodging<sup>1</sup> as part of the COVID-19 response by the County; and

13 WHEREAS the “24-hour hold back” of property before it could be cleaned and  
14 rented again remained effective through August 25, 2020 unless extended by the Board;  
15 and

16 WHEREAS pursuant to paragraph 1 of Order No. 6-20-169, paragraph 1a of Order  
17 No. 7-20-190 and paragraph 1a of Order No. 8-20-239 it was recognized by the County  
18 the Order could be rescinded, extended, or modified<sup>2</sup>; and

19 WHEREAS the Board by motion adopted August 24, 2020 extended the application  
20 period of the 24-hour hold through September 29, 2020<sup>3</sup>. This Order memorializes the  
21 extension adopted on August 24, 2020.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 23 1. That Order No. 8-20-239 is hereby modified as follows:

<sup>2</sup> All the cities in Lincoln County have a 3 hour hold back provision, 1 hour hold back or no restriction as of the date of this Order.

<sup>3</sup> The vote was 2-1 with Commissioners Hunt and Hall voting to extend, and Commissioner Jacobson voting against extension.


1 a. The 24-hour hold back of property before cleaning personnel may enter to clean  
2 the property remains in effect through September 29, 2020. The Board will review  
3 continuation or modification of that requirement before the end of the extension.


4 b. That in all other aspects the framework plan from Order No. 5-20-136 as  
5 extended by Order No. 6-20-169, Order No. 7-20-190 and Order No. 8-20-239 continues  
6 unchanged. This Order may be modified, rescinded or extended by authority of the Board  
7 of Commissioners.


