11 Lincoln County Order No. 6-20-169 extended restrictions on short term lodging¹ as
12 part of the COVID-19 response by the County; and

13 WHEREAS the “24-hour hold back” of property before it could be cleaned and
14 rented again remained effective through July 19, 2020 unless extended by the Board; and

15 WHEREAS pursuant to paragraph 1 of Order No. 6-20-169 it was recognized by the
16 County the Order could be rescinded, extended, or modified²; and

17 WHEREAS the Board by motion adopted July 13, 2020 extended the application
18 period of the 24-hour hold through August 18, 2020³. This Order memorializes the
19 extension adopted on July 13, 2020.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

21 1. That Order No. 6-2-169 is hereby modified as follows:

22 a. The 24-hour hold back of property before cleaning personnel may enter to clean
23 the property remains in effect through August 18, 2020. The Board will review
24 continuation or modification of that requirement before the end of the extension.

¹ Order No. 6-20-169 and all previous Orders addressing this issue are incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

² The City of Newport has already lifted this restriction, Only the City of Yachats continues the 24 hour hold back provision. The Yachats City Council will vote later this week on whether to continue the hold back. The Board’s action this date will be conveyed to the City prior to its vote.

³ The vote was 2-1 with Commissioners Hunt and Hall voting to extend, and Commissioner Jacobson voting against extension.

1 b. That in all other aspects the framework plan from Order 5-20-136 as extended by
2 Order 6-20-169 continues unchanged. This Order may be modified, rescinded or extended
3 by authority of the Board of Commissioners. A copy shall be provided to the City of
4 Yachats.




