11 Lincoln County Orders No. 6-20-169, 7-20-190, 8-20-239 and 8-20-253 extended
12 restrictions on short term lodging¹ as part of the COVID-19 response by the County; and

13 WHEREAS the “24-hour hold back” of property before it could be cleaned and
14 rented again remained effective through September 29, 2020 unless modified or extended
15 by the Board; and

16 WHEREAS pursuant to paragraph 1 of Order No. 6-20-169, paragraph 1a of Order
17 No. 7-20-190, paragraph 1a of Order No. 8-20-239, and paragraph 1a of Order No. 8-20-
18 253 it was recognized by the County the Order could be rescinded, extended, or modified²;
19 and

20 WHEREAS the Board by motion adopted September 21, 2020 rescinded the
21 application period of the 24-hour hold immediately³. This Order memorializes the
22 recission adopted on September 21, 2020.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

24 1. That Order No. 8-20-253 is hereby modified as follows:

² All the cities in Lincoln County have a 3 hour hold back provision, 1 hour hold back or no restriction as of the date of this Order.

³ The vote was 2-1 with Commissioners Jacobson and Hall voting to rescind, and Commissioner Hunt voting to keep the former date of September 29, 2020.


1 a. The 24-hour hold back of property before cleaning personnel may enter to clean
2 the property is removed effective immediately.


3 b. That in all other aspects the framework plan from Order No. 5-20-136 as
4 extended by Order No. 6-20-169, Order No. 7-20-190, Order No. 8-20-239 and Order 8-
5 20-253 continues unchanged. This Order may be modified, rescinded or extended by
