



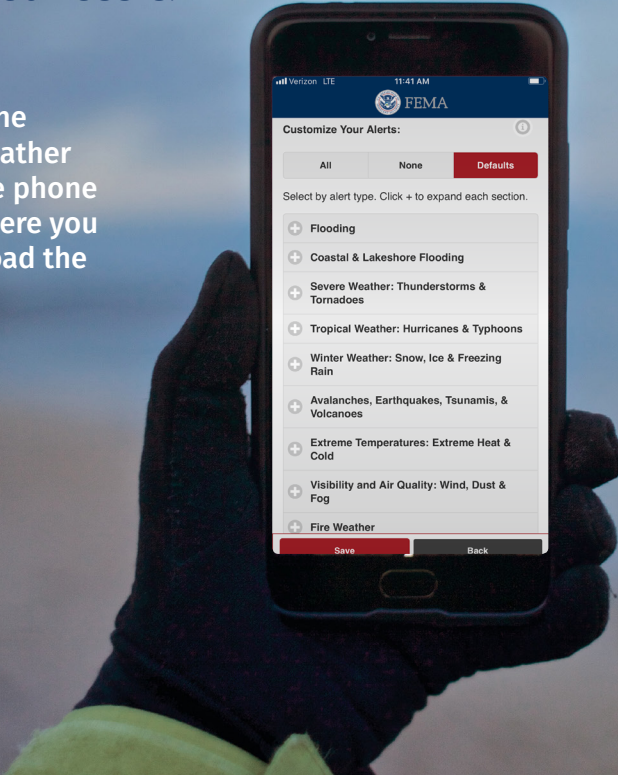
Lincoln County Sheriff's Office: Stay Connected with Weather Alerts

FEMA Mobile Preparedness & Weather Alerts App:

If you would like to receive the National Weather Service weather alerts directly to your mobile phone for the area you live in or where you are traveling to, then download the app at no cost to you.

- Receive real-time alerts from the National Weather Service for up to five locations nationwide.
- Learn emergency safety tips for over 20 types of disasters, including fires, flooding, hurricanes, snowstorms, tornadoes, volcanoes and more.
- Locate open emergency shelters and disaster recovery centers in your area where you can talk to a FEMA representative in person.
- Prepare for disasters with a customizable emergency kit checklist, emergency family plan, and reminders.
- Connect with FEMA to register online for disaster assistance.
- Upload and share disaster photos through Disaster Reporter.
- Toggle between English and Spanish.

Who needs a NOAA Weather Alert Radio?

Public safety experts agree. Receivers should be in every home. They are also valuable in public buildings, such as schools, hospitals, and places of worship.

NOAA Weather Alert Radio

Isn't just for emergencies. It's a round-the-clock source of weather reports, distant tsunami notices, and forecasts.

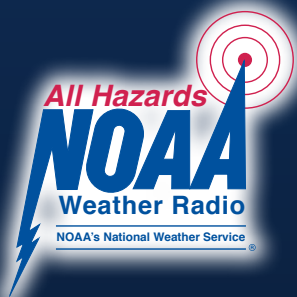
