To earn a Technician Class amateur radio license, all that is required is to pass a 35 question test, with at least 26 correct. All 400 (more or less) possible test questions, and the answers, are published and available for study. To help you do that, here are some resources and advice. **Be aware that there is a new Technician Question Pool as of July 1, 2018.**
