Student Privacy

All services are private and confidential. Health center records will not become part of a student's school record and information cannot be shared with school personnel without permission.

Confidentiality Notice

All services are confidential, however if we feel a student is in danger of hurting themselves or others or if harm of any kind is suspected, we are required to report this information. Animal bites and certain communicable diseases must also be reported. (OAR 309-33-200, 419B-010, 419B-015, 33-14-000 & ORS 433-004)

Oregon Laws

Students aged 15 years and older may access all services for themselves. Students aged 14 years and older may seek mental health, alcohol and drug services without parent permission. (ORS109.675)

Students of any age can receive care for sexually transmitted diseases and birth control information and services.
