ORDER NO. 7-17-213

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2017, by Order No. 6-17-171, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners initiated procedures for the dissolution of the Windy Bend Special Road District, hereinafter referred to as the "District"; and

WHEREAS, the proceedings were initiated pursuant to ORS 198.335 to ORS 198.365 based upon notification from the State of Oregon that the District had failed to provide the Oregon Department of Revenue with the required financial statements as set forth in ORS 294.458, for more than three consecutive years; and

WHEREAS, findings outlining a history of the District and of the proceedings to June 21, 2017, leading up to dissolution of the District are outlined in Order No. 6-17-171. These findings are hereby incorporated by reference into this order; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 198.350 the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners did file a financial statement of the District with the Lincoln County Clerk on or around June 21, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners did publish notice of the hearing on dissolution of the District in accordance with ORS 198.355(2); and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners did conduct a hearing on dissolving the District on Wednesday, July 19, 2017, at 9:30 A.M. as scheduled; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 198.365, the issues at the hearing are whether the District is active and whether there is a need for the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the District is not active, and that in fact, it has not been active for approximately 15 or more years. Further, as documented in Order No. 6-17-171, the District has not filed with the State the required financial reports for more than three consecutive years; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that there is not a need for the District; and

WHEREAS, no one at the hearing argued that the District should not be dissolved; and

WHEREAS, no one at the hearing presented claims against the District (ORS 198.355(2)); and


WHEREAS, the District has no known assets or debts;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:


- 1) The Windy Bend Special Road District is dissolved.
- 2) Pursuant to ORS 198.365, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners is the board of trustees for the District for purposes of paying debts and disposing of the property of the District. In that role the Board declares that there are no assets and no liabilities of the District. As a result, there will be no transferring of assets or payment of debts.
- 3) Pursuant to ORS 198.365, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners shall deliver the books and records of the District, if any, to the Lincoln County Clerk.
- 4) A copy of this order shall be delivered to Lincoln County Clerk Dana Jenkins, Lincoln County Assessor Joe Davidson, Lincoln County Counsel's Office for distribution to the Oregon Secretary of State and the Oregon Department of Revenue- Attention Danette Benjamin, and to Jim Bartlett, a prior District contact for the County, and owner of real property within the (former) District.


