### Agenda:

1. Call To Order. 3:10 pm by Chair Marci Baker. Start of meeting delayed due to technical difficulties.
2. Roll Call - Establishment of A Quorum. Four of the 5 members were present: Marci Baker, Chair; Woody Crobar, Vice Chair; Pamela Barlow-Lind, Member; Linda Neigebauer, Member. Bill Turner, Member, was absent.
3. Approval of 11-8-24 Minutes. Member Linda Neigebauer motioned to approve the 11-8-24 minutes. Vice Chair Crobar seconded the motion and all members approved.
4. 2025-2027 STIF Project Discussion with Cynda Bruce, Director of Lincoln Transit Department and Lincoln County Transportation Services District, and STIF Committee members.
5. Formal Recommendation to the Board of Commissioners  
STIF Advisory Committee Members make a formal recommendation to the Lincoln County BOC about which Lincoln County Department of Transit projects should be included in the 2025-2027 Biennial STIF application to the Oregon Department of transportation.  
  
Vice Chair Crobar motioned to make a formal recommendation to the Lincoln County BOC about which Lincoln County Department of Transit projects should be included in the 2025-2027 Biennial STIF application as determined by the Committee. Pamela Barlow-Lind seconded the motion and all members approved.
6. Public Comment. Lincoln County Administrator, Tim Johnson, advised the Committee of changes that the City of Newport is proposing to make on Highway 101 from just north of the City Hall and south to SW Abbey Street. The changes as proposed would impede the passage of Lincoln County Transit buses, of which some are 12 feet wide, by creating traffic lanes on Highway 101 and potentially a 9<sup>th</sup> Street couplet that will be 10 to 11 feet wide. The Committee asked that it be included in the minutes that the Committee will pursue Newport's traffic lane changes on behalf of County Transit.
7. Adjournment. Chair Marci Baker adjourned the meeting at 4:17 pm.
