Nighttime Winter Shelters

- Safe, affirming spaces for ALL, including pets

Where

Newport and Lincoln City

- 351 SW 7th St. Newport, OR 97365
- 2125 NW Hwy 101 Lincoln City, OR 97367

When

6pm to 7am, November - April

- Walk-up intakes from 6pm to 7pm only

Rides

Transportation to Either Shelter

- Rides start at 6pm and end at 3am
- **Need a Ride? Call 541-270-1005**

- Guests must be able to care for themselves in the shelter (staff cannot give medical care).
- Adults and pets are welcome (pet-care staff help with pets, and pets are fed).
- Once checked in, guests may not leave and re-enter.
- Guests must agree to follow the Shelter Rules (attached) and honor the quiet shelter setting.
- On-site screening includes emptying all pockets.
- Guests can keep with them: their cell phone; 1 set of clothes; 1 dose of required medication.
- Authorized personal belongings are securely stored and locked overnight.
- Food is given to guests after check-in. No food may be brought in.
